

HAND CARRY INFORMATION

What is Hand Carry?

Small items such as cartons and packages that can be hand carried by only one person through the main entrance of a facility during move-in and move-out that weighs less than 300 lbs.

Any mechanical assistance is limited to a small dolly (such as the luggage dolly shown below). The assistance of any motorized device or pallet jack is not permitted. When exhibitors choose to "hand carry" material, they may not be permitted access to the loading dock/freight door areas.

What does Hand Carry not include?

Hand carry does not include the use of the items listed below and is NOT ACCEPTABLE for personal use. The following items are prohibited and can not be used to transport any hand carry material during the move-in and move-out of the trade show by an exhibitor or their exhibitor appointed contractor (EAC).

Freeman has jurisdiction for the loading and unloading of all trucks, trailer and common and contract carriers as well as the handling of empty crates and the operation of material handling equipment.
